Gin Meets Paper Art **Extraordinary Charity Action at the Museum Haus des Papiers**

The Berlin-based Museum Haus des Papiers is receiving support from MAMPE Berlin and five artists who have created a unique special edition, including an individual gin. The proceeds from the sale will benefit the cultural venue and its charitable projects.

Creativity and an enthusiasm for the unusual and new are what unite the five artists: Cem Bora, Christiane Feser, Fee Kleiß, Finja Sander, and Jessica Maria Toliver, with the company philosophy of the MAMPE Manufaktur in Berlin. The distillery and transparent manufactory in Bergmannstraße are known for exquisite, regional spirits and are always breaking new ground with their refreshingly new concepts and recipes.

As part of the art festival "papier & klang" by Haus des Papiers, the artists were inspired by the handmade bottles, the high-quality spirits, and numerous distillates to create a special edition.

Each artist created five hand-signed bottles, each with an individual artistic concept. The composition of the bottle contents was also created by the artists especially for their work and then carefully distilled and composed by MAMPE Berlin.

The special editions combine the art of paper with the art of distillation. Only two bottles of each edition will be sold. One of the bottles will be auctioned on eBay from 07.09. to 17.09.2023 (search term "special edition Mampe"), and the other will be presented and offered at KaDeWe Berlin from October.

With the sale of the bottles, the artists and MAMPE Berlin support the non-profit Museum Haus des Papiers at Spittelmarkt. This year, the museum appeared for the first time as the organizer of the festival "papier & klang" by Haus des Papiers at four exhibition venues in the capital - and is now delighted about the wonderful support that this special project means for the museum.
