Only in HdP: Leiko Ikemura Combines Sculpture and Drawing

The Museum Haus des Papiers exclusively presents an unconventional new work by the internationally acclaimed artist Leiko Ikemura. For the first time in her body of work, Ikemura combines a sculpture made of the finest papier-mâché with a drawing in *Red Thoughts*, linking the two in a fascinating dialogue between materiality and artistic gesture.

The presentation of the artwork is thematically and formally reflected in the title of the current exhibition *Transformation Paper*. The exhibition will be on display until 8 June 2025. Tickets cost 8.50 euros, reduced 6.00 euros.

Haus des Papiers is a private museum located in the heart of Berlin, dedicated exclusively to contemporary sculptural paper art. It was founded in 2021 by Annette Berr and Ul Vohrer. With initiatives such as the *Paper Residency!* stipend program along with the renowned *Paper Art Award*, supported by sponsors d'mage, Hahnemühle and Canon Germany, the museum offers a platform for both established and emerging artists. In addition, Haus des Papiers is a place that is deeply committed to honoring all craftsmanship and artistic skill related to paper as a material, thus building up an active paper community step by step.
